ex. <i>elegant</i>		<i>elegantly</i>		He dresses very <b>elegantly</b> .
in - <b>y</b>	<i>easy</i>	-y → <b>i+ ly</b>	<i>easily</i>	She learnt to play the piano <b>easily</b> .
in - <b>le</b>	<i>simple</i>	-le → <b>- ly</b>	<i>simply</i>	Dad, can you explain it <b>simply</b> , please?
in - <b>l</b>	<i>punctual</i>	-al → <b>+ ly</b>	<i>punctually</i>	The train never arrives <b>punctually</b> .
in - <b>c</b>	<i>automatic</i>	-c → <b>+ ally</b>	<i>automatically</i>	This machine stops <b>automatically</b> .
