

# A LOT (LOTS) OF – MUCH / MANY – VERY & VERY MUCH SO & SO MUCH/MANY – TOO & TOO MUCH/MANY A LITTLE / A FEW – LITTLE / FEW

## Molto/i

**a lot (of) – lots (of)** + countable/uncountable noun (or NOTHING) in affirmative sent.

**much** + **uncountable** noun (or NOTHING) in interrogative and negative sentences

**many** + **plural countable** noun (or NOTHING) in interrogative and negative sentences

**very** + adjective /adverb

**very much** + verb

ex. *very happy / happily*

ex. *I like this very much*

ex. *a lot of time/people*

ex. *not much time*

ex. *...many people?*

## Così tanto /i

**so much** + **uncountable** noun or NOTHING

**so many** + **plural countable** noun or NOTHING

**so** + adjective / adverb

**so much** + verb

ex. *so much work*

ex. *so many problems*

ex. *so sad / sadly*

ex. *He wanted to travel so much*

## Troppo/i

**too much** + **uncountable** noun (or NOTHING)

**too many** + **plural countable** noun (or NOTHING)

**too** + adjective / adverb

**too much** + verb

ex. *too much sugar*

ex. *too many lessons*

ex. *too easy / easily*

ex. *You can't expect too much from him.*

## Un po'

**a little** + **uncountable** noun (or NOTHING)

**a few** + **plural countable** noun (or NOTHING)

ex. *a little beer*

ex. *a few biscuits*

## Poco/chi

**little** + **uncountable** noun (or NOTHING)

**few** + **plural countable** noun (or NOTHING)

ex. *little milk (left)*

ex. *(only) few apples*
